



CYFM Dress Code Policy

Capuchin Youth and Family Ministries is a community of believers striving to uphold the values of our faith. As a community we must help one another grow as faithful, loving people. One way to do this is through respecting and honoring our bodies. For this reason we ask that all those participating in C.Y.F.M events dress in a manner allowing all of us to grow closer to our loving God through a deeper respect for others. We ask all people to adhere to the following guidelines.

- Modesty in dress is expected at all times.
- Shorts and skirts must reach mid-thigh and past your fingertips, when arms are at your side, or longer.
- Shirts must remain on outside bathing/swimming activities.

The following are not permitted at C.Y.F.M events:

- Dresses and shorts that are shorter than mid-thigh
- Spaghetti straps
- Strapless tops
- Apparel, jewelry or references promoting messages inappropriate to C.Y.F.M such as, the use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or suggestive language
- Bare midriffs
- Any clothing that is extremely low cut or which exposes undergarments
